In January 1982, a team of nine researchers led by Dr. Richard C. Feynman at the Stanford Research Institute (SRI) in Menlo Park, California, developed AutoCAD using the FORTRAN programming language. Computer graphics at the time were done on mainframe and minicomputer platforms, with each CAD operator working at a separate terminal. At the time, the graphics rendering process was very slow and expensive. The speed at which the graphics could be displayed at was less than a tenth of a second, and the computer systems typically had a 2-3 megahertz CPU. In contrast, AutoCAD is a fast and easy-to-use piece of software that provides a rich environment for creating 2D and 3D drawings. It is designed to run on common consumer and business desktop computers, as well as on tablet devices. The first public version of AutoCAD was released in 1985. When the software was released, it could be purchased in a version for word processing systems for \$3,000, or as a standalone drawing program for \$2,500. "We saved you from many thousands of man-years of drawing and drafting," Dr. Feynman, the AutoCAD's inventor, said. "It really transformed the way in which people design things." AutoCAD's desktop-based graphics feature works similarly to the feature in most video games. AutoCAD is released in both retail and online (Amazon) stores. The retail package comes with AutoCAD, which is also available on DVD and USB flash drives. The retail package is \$2,690 for AutoCAD, AutoCAD LT (for use on desktop computers), AutoCAD LT Mobile Edition, and AutoCAD Map 3D. The retail package also includes a handheld tablet pen. The online package includes AutoCAD or AutoCAD LT, as well as the application builder, and an optional subscription to Autodesk Design Review (Preview). The subscription provides the ability to quickly view, modify, and annotate AutoCAD files, with no need to buy the software again.
